In the garden this month

Prune cold-sensitive summer- and autumn-flowering shrubs and shrubby perennials

Keep giving liquid feeds to spring annuals and bulbs.

Aerate and fertilise lawns

In the vegie patch, keep maturing crops growing well with regular soluble feeds and think about what to plant for the warmer months ahead, such as tomatoes, cucumbers, zucchini, eggplants, beans, and herbs such as basil.

Plant asparagus, carrots, lettuce, mustard greens, rhubarb, potatoes, peas, spring onions, rocket, silver beet and turnips .

Start tomatoes under cover.

Plant Alyssum, begonia, celosia, cosmos, marigold, petunia, portulaca, salvia, verbena and zinnia.

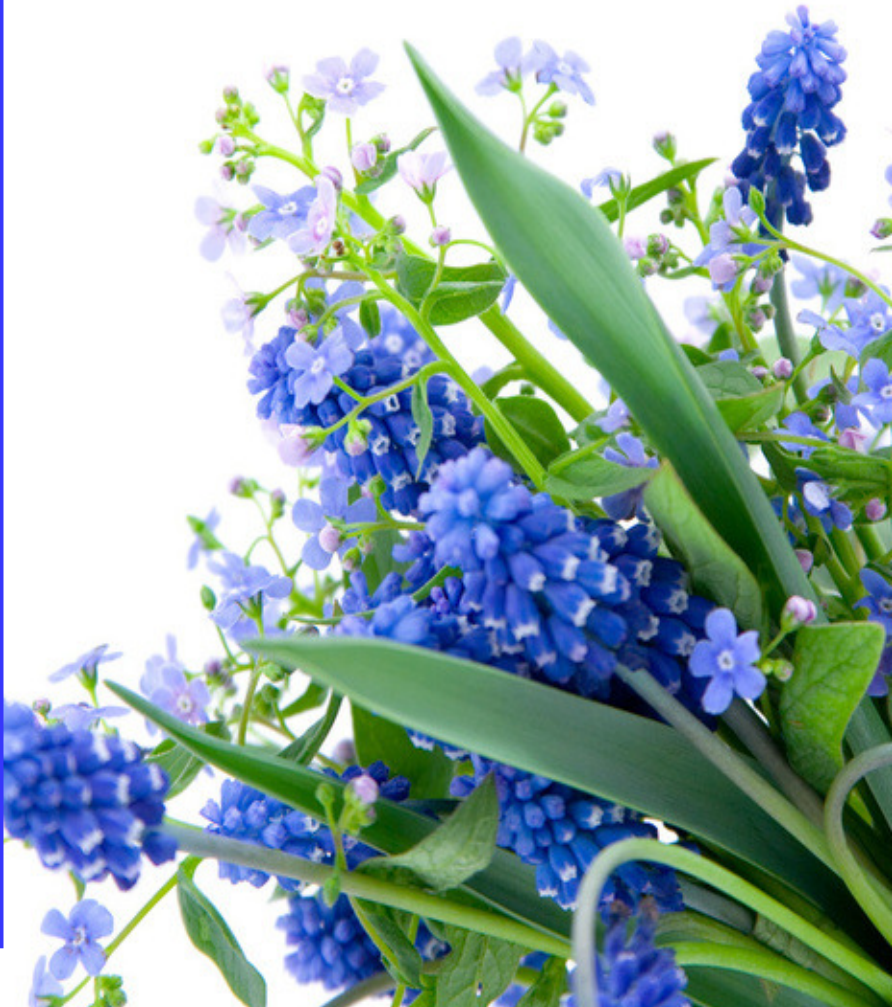
Check for sooty mould or scale on lemon trees

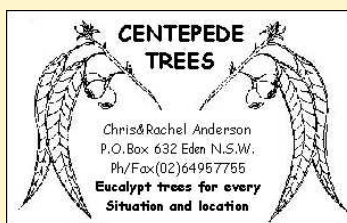
