The Pantry sells farm fresh eggs, local jams and preserves, dressings, honey and house made dips, mueslis and other yummy goods. Every Friday, Saturday and Sunday the Pantry has a small selection of fresh, seasonal, home grown fruit, vegetables and herbs. The Pantry also has a range of practical kitchen ware, cookbooks and specialised local produce hampers which make great gifts for foodie friends and family.

Oaklands Animal Nursery is undergoing a few changes and will now be open 7 days per week. Soon the nursery will be available for children's birthday parties with merry go round, pony rides and food!

In the garden this month

- Liquid feed vegetables and ornamentals fortnightly. Apply slow release fertilisers to garden beds and shrubs.
- Mow lawns once a fortnight just removing one third of the blade growth. Fertilise to make sure the lawn is in top conditions before its winter growth slows.
- Spray new foliage of citrus to prevent citrus leaf miner bug.
- Plant winter crops such as cauliflower, beans, broccoli and peas, and plant year round crops such as garlic, potatoes, carrots and silverbeet.
- Plant herbs in your kitchen garden
- Mulch garden beds 80cm thick with a coarse free draining mulch. (Don't mulch up close to plant stems or they'll rot). Dead-head roses and kangaroo paws to promote autumn blooms.
- Apply a wetting agent and fertilizer to garden beds and lawns to get them into top condition ready for winter. Pick up fallen leaves and add them to your compost heap.
- Harvest mature pumpkins, sweet potatoes, ginger and potatoes for winter storage.
- Visit an open garden for inspiration!
